ORIGINAL/LONG-TERM OWNER: USED AS A HOUSE UNTIL IT WAS CONVERTED INTO A CHAPEL CA.1930, WITH LARGE ADDITION ON SOUTH SIDE VIA PERMIT #1283/1941 (\$1,800). BECAME WELL-KNOWN BECAUSE IT TOOK CHARGE OF THE REMAINS OF DR. LOUIS SLOTIN (1910-1946), WINNIPEG PHYSICIST WHO DIED FROM RADIATION POISONING AFTER AN ACCIDENT DURING NUCLEAR EXPERIMENTS IN NEW MEXICO IN MAY 1946. A LARGE ADDITION TO SOUTH SIDE COMPLETED IN 1941.
