


Winnipeg Population Estimates and Projections June 2022 Update

Introduction


This document provides historical and projected population estimates for the City of Winnipeg and Winnipeg Census Metropolitan Area (CMA). In recent years prior to the COVID-19 pandemic, the City of Winnipeg had experienced strong population growth primarily due to international migration. However, the COVID-19 pandemic temporarily reduced population growth. Due to the uncertainty of certain population growth components in the future, a range of forecasts has been provided. Despite temporary slowdowns in population growth, the City of Winnipeg is still expected to reach a population of one million people by 2047 in a baseline scenario.

Three scenarios for local population growth are presented, with each scenario containing different assumptions about trends in fertility, international, interprovincial, and inter-city migration. The baseline scenario is recommended for most municipal planning purposes.

- 3. Population projections developed by City of Winnipeg Economic Research, based on data from the following sources:
- Statistics Canada for fertility rates, mortality rates, population by age and gender, and population change by component
- Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA) 2019 Community Health Assessment report for fertility rate adjustments
- Conference Board of Canada Metropolitan 1 Spring 2022 data for component forecasts
- 4. The short-term 5-year forecast methodology is developed, in part, by observing recent historical trends in population changes. The long-term population forecast beyond year 5 is based on holding year 5 forecast assumptions constant for the remainder of the forecast period.
- 5. Fertility rate scenarios are developed based on Statistics Canada's Low, Medium, and High Population Projections for Canada (2018 to 2068), Provinces and Territories (2018 to 2043) for the Province of Manitoba. Provincial Total Fertility Rates (TFR)s are obtained from Table 3.2 in *Population Projections for Canada (2018 to 2068), Provinces and Territories (2018 to 2043): Technical Report on Methodology and Assumptions, Chapter 3: Projection of Fertility,* and further adjusted for the CMA using public data from the Winnipeg Regional Health Authority (WRHA).
- * 2021 Winnipeg CMA boundary now includes the Town of Niverville. The 2021 Winnipeg CMA census population count is not comparable to previous census counts. All other figures in this report represent 2016 boundaries.
