## Are you an eligible voter?

You can vote in the election, if:

- You are a Canadian citizen
- You are at least 18 years of age
- You have lived in the City of Winnipeg since April 25, 2006
- You do not live in the City of Winnipeg, but you owned or rented property in the City since April 25, 2006
- You are not prohibited from voting under any law

## Who are you voting for?

---

You can vote for:

- one candidate for Mayor
- one candidate for Councillor
- up to four candidates for School Trustee

Note: If you do not live in Winnipeg, you can not vote for School Trustee

## Are you on the Voters List?

- If your name is on the Voters List, a voters notice will be mailed to you in early October
- If you do not receive a voters notice, or if your address has changed, please call the Election Office
- If your name is not on the Voters List, when you attend the voting place you will be required to present identification and take an oath affirming that you are an eligible voter

## When can you vote?

- Election Day is Wednesday, October 25
- Voting places are open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day
- You can vote in advance beginning October 2 through to October 20

## Where do you vote?

- Remember to bring your Voters Notice AND identification with you to the voting place
- If you do not receive a voters notice, or if your address has changed, please call the Election Office

## What type of identification is required?

New for this Election, the City of Winnipeg will require all voters to provide identification at voting places.

Voters will be asked to provide:

- one piece of photo identification that contains their name and address, **or**
- two other pieces of identification, one of which must contain their address

Examples of other acceptable documents are Manitoba Health Services Commission card, Manitoba Blue Cross card, a blank personalized cheque, a credit card statement, an Old Age Pension/Security card, an Income Tax Assessment statement or a utility bill

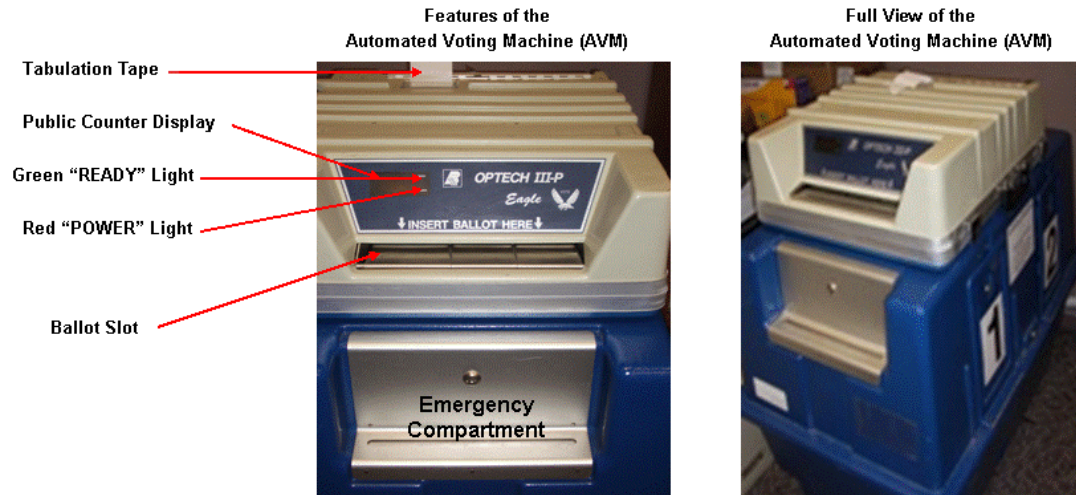

## What is automated voting?

Automated voting is the use of machines which scan the ballots and provide for quick and accurate counting of the votes



The AVM reads the ballot as it is deposited into the ballot box and increases the number count by one, stores the information and prints cumulative totals of all votes cast after the close of voting

## What does the ballot look like?

The ballot contains the names of candidates for all three Offices to be voted: Office of Mayor and Office of Councillor and the Office of School Trustee. The ballot is colour coded white for Mayor, pink for Councillor and yellow for School Trustee. The candidates' names appear in random order

## When are the results of the Election available?

- At the close of voting, 8:00 p.m., Election Day an Election Officer will cause the voting machine to tabulate the votes cast and transport the results to Election Headquarters
- The election results will be reported by the Senior Election Official within 90 minutes of the close of voting
- The election results will be published on the election web site
