Voter Eligibility

To vote for Councillor in this by-election you must be:

- a Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older;
- an actual resident or land owner in the City of Winnipeg for a period of at least six months (since September 17, 2008);
- an actual resident or land owner in the River Heights-Fort Garry Ward on By-Election Day (March 17, 2009).

To vote for School Trustee (if applicable), you must be:

- a Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older;
- an actual resident of the Winnipeg School Division for a period of at least six months (since September 17, 2008);
- a resident in the School Division Ward on the day of the by-election.

IMPORTANT

ALL applicants are required to provide proof of identity. If applying in writing, you **must** enclose legible copies of ID, either an official document issued by the federal, provincial or municipal government that contains your name, address and photograph, such as a valid Driver's License, OR two documents that provide evidence of identity and your current address. A Sealed Envelope Ballot package will be mailed to you with instructions. If your application is received less than 12 days before the By-Election (after Thursday, March 5, 2009), you must make alternate arrangements to have the package delivered to you.

In-person applications will be accepted commencing **Friday, February 27, 2009**. Eligible voters who apply in person will receive a Sealed Envelope Ballot package at that time.
