An eligible voter who applies to vote by Sealed Envelope Ballot less than 12 days before By-Election Day, (after Thursday, March 5, 2009), may designate **in writing** a relative, spouse or common-law partner to deliver the Sealed Envelope Ballot package to him or her.

 - (a) an official document issued by a federal, provincial or municipal government that contains his or her name, address and photograph, such as a valid Driver's License; OR
 - (b) at least two other documents that provide evidence of his or her identity.
