WHEREAS the Autobin collection system has been haphazard during the past year with the contractor and the Water and Waste Department monitoring the level of garbage in the bins before making the decision to empty them;

AND WHEREAS overflowing Autobins create unsanitary conditions in back lanes and are thus a health problem;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Autobin pickup be serviced every 7 calendar days.
