Revise:	B2.1 to read:	The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, January 12, 2007.	
Revise:	B9.1 to read:	The Bidder shall state a price in Canadian funds for each item of the Work identified Form B: Prices.	
Add:	B9.1.1	The Bidder shall submit bids for both Alternative 1 and Alternative 2. Bids received for or one Alternative will be considered non-responsive.	
Revise:	B15.1(c) to read:	Bid Price	
Revise:	B15.4 to read:	Further to B15.1(c), the Bid Price shall be the sum of the quantities multiplied by the unit price for each item shown on Form B: Prices.	
Delete:	B15.4.1		
Add:	B15.5	This Contract may be awarded separately by item (Alternative 1 or Alternative 2).	
Add	B15.5.1	Notwithstanding B9.1, the Bidder shall submit bids for both Alternative 1 and Alternative 2, but is not required to bid on both items in Alternative 1 and Alternative 2.	

The City has the right to choose the alternative that is in its best interests.

PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D2.2(a) to read: The major components of the Work associated with Alternative 1 and Alternative 2 are as

follows:

Add: D2.2(e) The supply and installation of a modified bituminous two-ply roof.

Clarification: D2.2(e) Specifications for the roof installation will be released to Bidders mid-December, 2006.

Add: D2.3 The major components of the Work associated with Alternative 2 are as specified in D2.2

and the supply and installation of a cementitious roof topping as specified in Section 03414.

Add: D15.4 The City of Winnipeg will endeavour to award the Contract within 30 Calendar Days of

the Submission Deadline. If award is not made within that time period, Contract Dates identified in D16 Critical Stages will be extended by an equivalent number of Calendar

Days until such a time an award is made.

Revise: D16.1(a) to read: Installation of the precast roof panels for the WM area shall be completed by no later than

July 11th, 2007.

Revise: D16.1(d) to read: Installation of the precast roof panels for the WR, WO, WF area shall be completed by no

later than November 14th, 2007.

Add: D16.2 With reference to Drawings SCH #1 and SCH #2, these show the general sequencing of

the work for the precast roof panels for the two conditions, (1) with a topping and (2) without a topping. These Drawings are provided for information only and are not intended

to replace the Contract Work Schedule.

PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Add: E3.5.1 With reference to Drawing SK – CM#1, this shows the layout and expected elevation of

perimeter access roads, provided by others, around the site at the period when the precast

roof panels are scheduled to be erected.

Revise: E3.1 to read: The Contractor shall have unlimited access to the Site on a 24 hour, 7 day basis providing

that the Contract Administrator is given 7 Calendar Days notice of work shifts that fall

outside the Business Day hours of 07.00 to 18.00.

Revise: E3.9 to read: With reference to Drawings marked PCL-01 and SK2, this information provides details of

the existing tower cranes on the site complete with the radii, load and boom & hook height

information.

Add: E3.9.1 The Contractor shall satisfy himself, when operating mobile cranes within the radii of these

tower cranes, that contact with these tower cranes is not possible, whether the tower cranes are in use or not. These tower cranes are free to windsail to suit the wind direction and therefore they must be operated if contact with this Contractor's cranes is possible. The cost of providing operators for these tower cranes, if required, shall be paid for by the

Contractor and is incidental to the Work.
