PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D5.9 (Addendum # 3) to read: Preliminary, detailed design and **contract administration** for the manhole replacement at Mile 93.69 including;

- (a) structural assessment of the Aqueduct to support a larger manhole stack that is ether 900mm or 1200mm internal diameter. It should be noted that the existing frame and cover will be reused; and
- (b) constructability of the replacement manhole shall be considered based on the conditions and location of the site.

D10.1 (a)(i) to read: restoration of mile 83.02 Boathouse along the Aqueduct.

Add: D10.1 (b) (iii) Preliminary, detailed design and contract administration for the manhole replacement at Mile 93.69.

D10.1 (b) (iv) Stop log design verification.

D10.1 (b) (v) Safety hoist design verification.

D10.1(c) The eight areas of work shall be completed by the end of 2012.

D10.1(c) (i) It shall be the responsibility of the Proponent to develop a strategy such that the works at the various boathouses, Aqueduct underdrains, drainage siphons, and manhole replacement are grouped within a reasonable geographic location. The grouped areas may be put out as a bid opportunity without compromising the critical stages indicated in D 10.1(a) and D 10.1(b).

D10.1(c) (ii) It shall be the responsibility of the Proponent to determine the required number of bid opportunities, scope of bid opportunities and organize the works such that they fit within the program budget.
