PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D4.2.2(d)(ii) to read: At minimum, the methodology shall:

- be consistent with methodology identified in the CCME 1999 Recommended Waste Characterization Methodology for Direct Waste Analysis Studies in Canada or other comparable industry standards
- consist of four (4) seasonal study periods (winter, spring, summer, and fall)
- undertake ten (10) SFD samples, and five (5) MFD samples at the BRRMF each season
- undertake thirteen (13) SFD samples, five (5) MFD samples, and two (2) recycling depot samples at the MRF each season
- samples shall be approximately 100kg each
- be representative of sub-populations across each sector

Add D4.3(a)(iii) Number of samples per season shall be ten (10).

Add D4.3(b)(ii) Number of samples per season shall be five (5).
