# PART D - SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Add: D15.4 The City intends to award by February 24, 2016.

D15.4.1 If the actual date of award is later than the intended date, the dates specified for

Commencement, Critical Stages, Substantial Performance, and Total Performance will be adjusted by the difference between the aforementioned intended and actual dates.

Revise D16.1 The Contractor shall achieve Substantial Performance by June 17, 2016.

## **PART E - SPECIFICATIONS**

Revise: E16.2 The first phase of the project is near completion and subject to site surface restoration

later this spring. The trenchless contractor has removed the rig mats used for the project.

Revise: E16.3 The Contractor shall review Appendix C – Historical Drawings in conjunction with the

outlined site access to assess the extent at which their methodology will impact the existing feedermain. Based on the determined construction impact the Contractor shall be responsible to take necessary precautions, subject to the approval of the Contract Administrator, to protect existing buried infrastructure while accessing the site during the

course of construction.

Revise: E16.7 (a) to read: Distribute vehicular loadings at any location where within 6m traveling along or crossing

of the feedermain is required.

Add: E19.11 The following are approved air vacuum and release valves for this project:

i) VENT-O-MAT RBX

ii) APCO CAV Model 151C

iii) Approved equal in accordance with B7

Revise: E20.3(c) Polyethylene to Polyethylene joints: to be either thermal butt fusion joined to ASTM

D2657 or by electrofusion coupler of the same DR rating to ASTM F1055. If electrofusion is used the manufacturer or manufacturer's representative must witness and certify the

installation.

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Add E20.4 (h) Prim

Primary system used for the interior / exterior finish of steel pipe shall be to AWWAC210 Fusion Bonded Epoxy. Other listed interior / exterior finishes shall be used as methods of finishes are in the case of demands to the primary system and the control of the

field repair in the case of damage to the primary system onsite.

Add: E20.10 (b) The following are approved flanged / compression sleeve couplings for this project:

i) Robar 1908RSC

ii) Approved equal in accordance with B7

Revise: E20.11 (b) to read: Exposed service - galvanized carbon steel bolts conforming to ASTM A307 Grade B with

galvanized carbon steel nuts conforming to ASTM A307 Grade 2H, semi-finished hex

head.

Add: E20.12 (c) The following are approved joint restraints for this project:

i) EBAA 2500 C905

- ii) EBBA 2800 C905
- iii) Or approved equal in accordance with B7.

#### Add: E30 EXPEDITED SHOP DRAWINGS

E30.1 Further to E8 in order to expedite Shop Drawings with critical timeliness, the Lowest Responsive Bidder, as outlined in **B15**, will be permitted, after receiving written approval from the Contract Administrator, to arrange for the preparation of Shop Drawings for the following items with critical timelines:

- (a) Butterfly Valves
- (b) Steel Transition Section
- (c) Ductile Iron Valve Chamber Pieces
- (d) Couplers
- (e) Dismantling Joint

E30.2 If Award is made to the lowest responsive bidder, then as indicated in E8.14, no payment for the preparation of Shop Drawings will be made.
