## **PART B - BIDDING PROCEDURES**

Add B10.3 as follows:

B10.3 Further to B10.1 and B10.2, the Consultant shall not assign to the Work or the Project any person who is a member of a heritage, cultural or arts board of directors (or other governing body) within the City of Winnipeg or Province of Manitoba. Proponents may not propose persons for the Work of this Contract who are members of a heritage, cultural or arts board (or other governing body) within the City of Winnipeg or Province of Manitoba.

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:**

- Q1. Has the Task Force met yet?
  - A1. No, not yet
- **Q2.** Have a Terms of Reference for the Task Force been established?
  - **A2.** Terms of reference have not yet been finalized.
- Q3. Does the City and Task Force see the role of the consultant primarily as a coordination/facilitation role or are they looking for some strategic advice as well?
  - **A3.** Coordination and facilitation are the primary role, but may not be limited to those roles.
- Q4. Can you provide any further clarity as to what the tasks "perform research" and "perform jurisdictional reviews" that would help us better define our methodology for the proposal.
