Update No. 8 – Project information & anticipated RFQ posting date.

The North End Sewage Treatment Plant (NEWPCC) is the City of Winnipeg's largest sewage treatment plant at 302 MLD and provides approximately 70% of the City's sewage treatment, serving a population of 404,000. The City is in the process of upgrading plant technology to meet both requirements of a Manitoba Regulatory License, and to replace end-of-life equipment.

The NEWPCC Upgrade project will be implemented in phases by creating three capital projects as follows:

- NEWPCC Upgrade: Power Supply and Headworks Facilities
- NEWPCC Upgrade: Biosolids Facilities
- NEWPCC Upgrade: Nutrient Removal Facilities
