PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B8.2 to read: The Proposal shall include fees based on a Time Basis for Resident Services. Time Based fees shall be based on providing one full time inspector during the course of the Work. For proposal purposes these fees should be based on seventy (70) working days at 10 hours per day to Substantial Performance. The proposed fee should include allowance for disbursements, including vehicle, electronic communication, etc. The actual working days will be established at time of tender with the consultation and concurrence of the Department.

PART D – SCOPE OF SERVICES

Revise: D4.2 to read: The consultant shall consider the feasibility of completing all the required work prior to March 16, 2018. If it is deemed that all work cannot be completed in that timeframe, the consultant shall propose a prioritized work schedule that splits the proposed work into two separate contracts, work to be completed in the winter of 2017/18 and work to be completed in the winter of 2018/19.

Revise: D4.4 to read: The Fort Rouge Park Outfall shall only be cleaned, CCTV televised, and recommendations regarding repair or rehabilitations provided to the Project Manager for determination of further action. No geotechnical investigations are required at this location.
