Revise:	B21.8 to read:	Further to B21.1(e), Experience of Key Personnel Assigned to the Project will be evaluated considering the experience and qualifications of the Key Personnel and Subconsultant personnel on Projects of comparable size and complexity, in accordance with B10, including but not limited to the following criteria:
		 (a) appropriateness of related years of experience of the Key Personnel; (b) relevancy of experience of the Key Personnel; and (c) appropriateness of approach to overall team formation and coordination of team members.
