Revise: B2.1 The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, April 5, 2024.

### PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Add: E8.12.1 Submit proposed construction equipment specifications to the Contract Administrator for

review a minimum of five (5) Business Days prior to construction. The equipment

submission shall include:

(a) equipment operating and payload weights;

(b) equipment dimensions, including wheel or track base, track length or axle

spacing, track widths or wheel configurations; and

(c) load distributions in the intended operating configuration.

Submit a construction method statement to the Contract Administrator a minimum of five (5) business days prior to construction. The construction method statement shall contain

the following minimum information:

(a) proposed construction plan including excavation locations, haul routes,

excavation equipment locations, and loading positions;

- (b) excavation plans, including shoring designs, for excavations occurring in close proximity to feeder mains (within 5 m horizontal of the pipe's centerline) where the excavation/shoring system is to be extended below the top of the feeder mains embedment zone (150 mm above the pipe); and,
- (c) any other pertinent information required to accurately describe the construction activities in close proximity to the feeder main and permit the Contract Administrator to review the proposed construction plans.

Revise: E16.3.3 Notwithstanding E16.3.1 and E17.3.1, temporary restoration for areas identified in E16.3.2 shall be completed using compacted granular backfill to grade. Temporary concrete and landscaping are not required.

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Q1: The south side of Inkster is to be completed as temporary restoration only. What about the landscaping? Does Top Soil & Sod need to be allowed for on the south Blvd? How about the centre Blvd (where water services are being renewed to the N. P/L)?

A1: For everything south of median centerline, only temporary restoration is required using flood-tamped granular to grade (refer to E16.3). Temporary concrete and landscaping are not required. The intent is that finished areas are left tidy, safe, and passable for pedestrians. Permanent restoration will be completed by the road works contractor under 155-2024.

For everything north of median centerline, full permanent restoration is required including pavement slabs, sidewalk slabs, and landscaping. This includes the north half of the center median, westbound traffic lanes, north boulevard and north sidewalk of lnkster Blvd and any cross streets.
