





Context and Design Approach:

Chester Square Park is located in a residential neighbourhood between City Avenue and Stockdale Street and is south of Roblin Boulevard. The Kindermusik Discovery daycare is within five blocks of Chester Square Park. The site is scattered with mature trees and divided by a drainage swale crossed by a bridge in the centre of the park. Our approach was to gather the play areas into the largest open space in the park and redirect the existing pathway to create an active play node. Additional seating has been provided for parental supervision and picnics. Due to the residential nature of the neighbourhood and lack of surrounding play equipment, we recommend that the play equipment for Chester Square Park be aimed at children aged 2-12. The existing sandbox is to be relocated and reused.

Swing Area 'A' to contain:

- One Swingset with 2 bays (1 Bay Belt Seats, 1 Bay Baby Seats).

Play Structure Area 'B' to contain:

- One or more Play structure(s) or Play Equipment to accommodate children ages 2 to 12.
- Minimum of one slide must face north or east.

- Minimum of one piece of equipment for climbing.
- An accessible structure or equipment as well as ground-level equipment. Creative play opportunities should be provided at or under the base of the structures.
