

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS – UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA TESTING:

Question: *Where can I take the Candidate Physical Fitness Evaluation?*

The University of Manitoba administers tests for the WFPS during the recruitment process, for more information on how to schedule for the test, fees, and requirements please visit <http://umanitoba.ca/faculties/kinrec/bsal/programs/occupation/fire/> for the Firefighter Paramedic assessment and <http://umanitoba.ca/faculties/kinrec/bsal/programs/occupation/paramedic/> for the Paramedic assessment. Please note that all tests must be current and have been completed within the previous six (6) months. The University of Manitoba only provides this testing during the recruitment process; once the bulletin is closed this testing is not offered again until the next recruitment period.

Question: *Do you accept the Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT)?*

As of April 27, 2007, the Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Service adopted a new job related physical fitness standard for all recruits – the Candidate Physical Fitness Evaluation. The Winnipeg Fire Paramedic Service will no longer be accepting CPAT as an alternative physical test. All applicants will have to successfully complete the testing administered by the University of Manitoba.
