## SECOND QUARTER REPORT 2011

---

The Mayors' Environmental Advisory Committee is pleased to submit a summary of its activities for the second quarter (April 1st to June 30th) of 2011:

### GOVERNANCE AND MEETINGS

---

MEAC held three regular meetings during the second quarter of 2011: April 18, May 16 and June 20.

### DELEGATIONS HEARD

---

At its April 2011 MEAC meeting, the committee heard three delegations:

- Colleen Kuruluk, the Manager of Marketing Programs at Manitoba Hydro spoke to Hydro's various Power Smart programs.
- Eric Witkowski, an engineer from Manitoba Hydro spoke to LED street lighting projects in the City of Winnipeg.
- Gerald Alcock of the City of Winnipeg's Public Works Department was present to address questions regarding Public Works Specific Questions around City lighting projects and other energy conservation initiatives.

At the May 2011 meeting the committee heard a presentation by Tim Yusishen, Founder and Chief Executive Officer of Solar Solutions on solar energy.

In June 2011 MEAC received a presentation on "Education for a Sustainable Future" from Carolee Buckler, Co-Chair of the Manitoba Education for Sustainable Development Working Group (Province of Manitoba) and Jackie Avent, Active and Safe Routes to School Program Coordinator (Green Action Centre).

### MEAC'S ACTIVITIES

On Saturday May 7, 2011, MEAC convened for a full day strategic planning session. A review of current and emerging priorities was completed. Development of a 3-year strategic plan will be continued in the third quarter of 2011.
