



# Winnipeg Police Service Chain of Command & Ranks



*A uniform member's rank is worn on the epaulets on the top of their shoulders:*

- ◆ **CHIEF OF POLICE:** Three pips surmounted by a crown; no badge number
- ◆ **DEPUTY CHIEF:** Two pips surmounted by a crown; no badge number
- ◆ **SUPERINTENDENT:** One pip surmounted by a crown; no badge number
- ◆ **INSPECTOR:** One crown; no badge number
- ◆ **STAFF SERGEANT:** Four inverted chevrons above badge number
- ◆ **SERGEANT:** Three chevrons surmounted by a crown above badge number
- ◆ **PATROL SERGEANT:** Three chevrons above badge number
- ◆ **DETECTIVE SERGEANT:** Plainclothes (Equivalent to Patrol Sergeant)
- ◆ **SENIOR CONSTABLE:** One chevron above badge number
- ◆ **CONSTABLE:** Badge number
- ◆ **CIVILIAN MEMBERS:** Seniority may be determined by an employee's staff number
