## **Requirements for Hydromassage Bathtubs**

## **Effective October 1, 2008**

Hydromassage bathtubs that are **located in a room that does not contain a watercloset and/or a wash basin**, will be required to comply with the rules of Section 68, Pools, tubs, and spas, of the Winnipeg Electrical By-law. This shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- No receptacles shall be located within 1.5m of the tub and all receptacles that are located from 1.5m to within 3m of the tub shall be protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI)
- 2. All luminaires and lighting equipment installed within 3m of the tub, measured radially from the top of the tub, and not separated by a wall or other permanent barrier shall be protected by a GFCI.
- 3. The on-off device required for the hydromassage tub shall be:
  - a. protected by a GFCI and
  - b. located behind a barrier or located not less than 1m from the tub, unless it is an integral part of an approved factory-built bathtub.
- 4. All switches for luminaires, lighting equipment, exhaust fans, etc. shall be located at least 1m from the tub.
- 5. Communication jacks (i.e. telephone) shall not be installed within 3m of the tub.
- 6. All other electrical equipment that is within 3m of the tub and not suitably separated from the tub area by a wall or other permanent barrier shall be protected by a GFCI.

## Note:

All distances noted above shall be measured horizontally from the inside top wall of the tub, unless noted otherwise.
