**ORIGINAL/LONG-TERM OWNER:** THE PRESBYTERIAN CONGREGATION USED THIS CHURCH UNTIL ITS SALE IN 1977 TO THE FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION KNOWN AS THE ELKS OF CANADA (INCORPORATED IN VANCOUVER, B.C. IN 1912, BASED ON THE AMERICAN GROUP THAT HAD BEEN IN OPERATION SINCE 1868). THIS CLUB, KNOWN AS LODGE #10, WAS SOLD IN 1988 TO ST. BONIFACE EVANGELICAL CHRISTIAN CHURCH INC AND BY THE EARLY 1990s WAS USED AS THE CROSSROAD MENNONITE BRETHERN CHURCH.
