**ORIGINAL/LONG-TERM OWNER:** FAIRBANKS-MORSE WAS FOUNDED IN BELOIT, WISCONSIN IN THE 1870s AS A WINDMILL BUILDER AND IN 1893 PRODUCED THE FIRST COMMERCIALY SUCCESSFUL GASOLINE ENGINE. IT OCCUPIED THIS WAREHOUSE UNTIL THE LATE 1930s, FARM IMPLEMENT MANUFACTURER MASSEY-HARRIS COMPANY OCCUPIED THE BUILDING BEGINNING IN THE EARLY 1940s.
