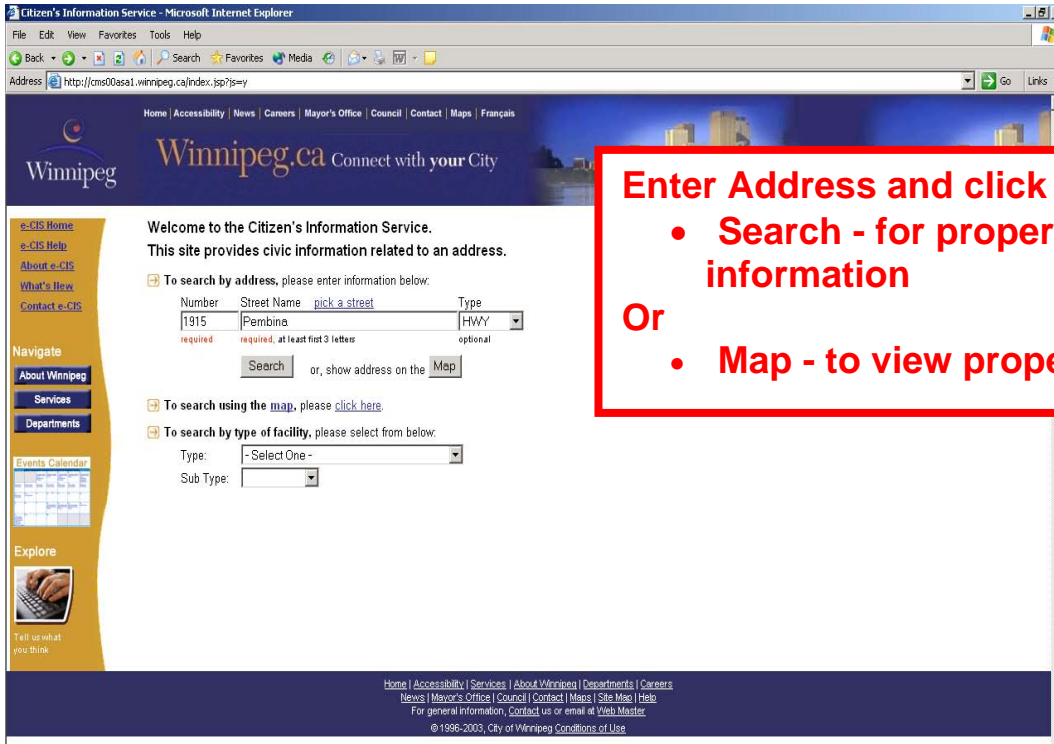

Search for Zoning by Address

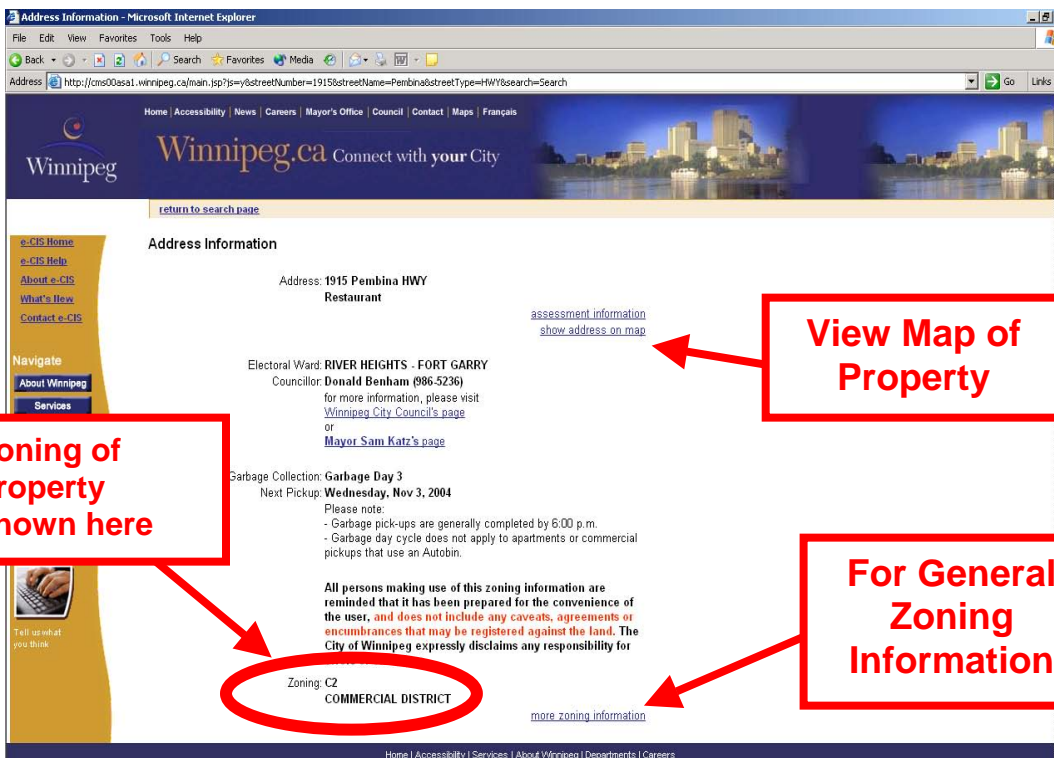


Enter Address and click on:

Search by Type of Facility

This is another way of getting information from the Citizen Information System by locating properties categorized by types of facilities (e.g. Recreation Facilities, Heritage Buildings, etc.). The intent is to be able to find information on by predefined categories.

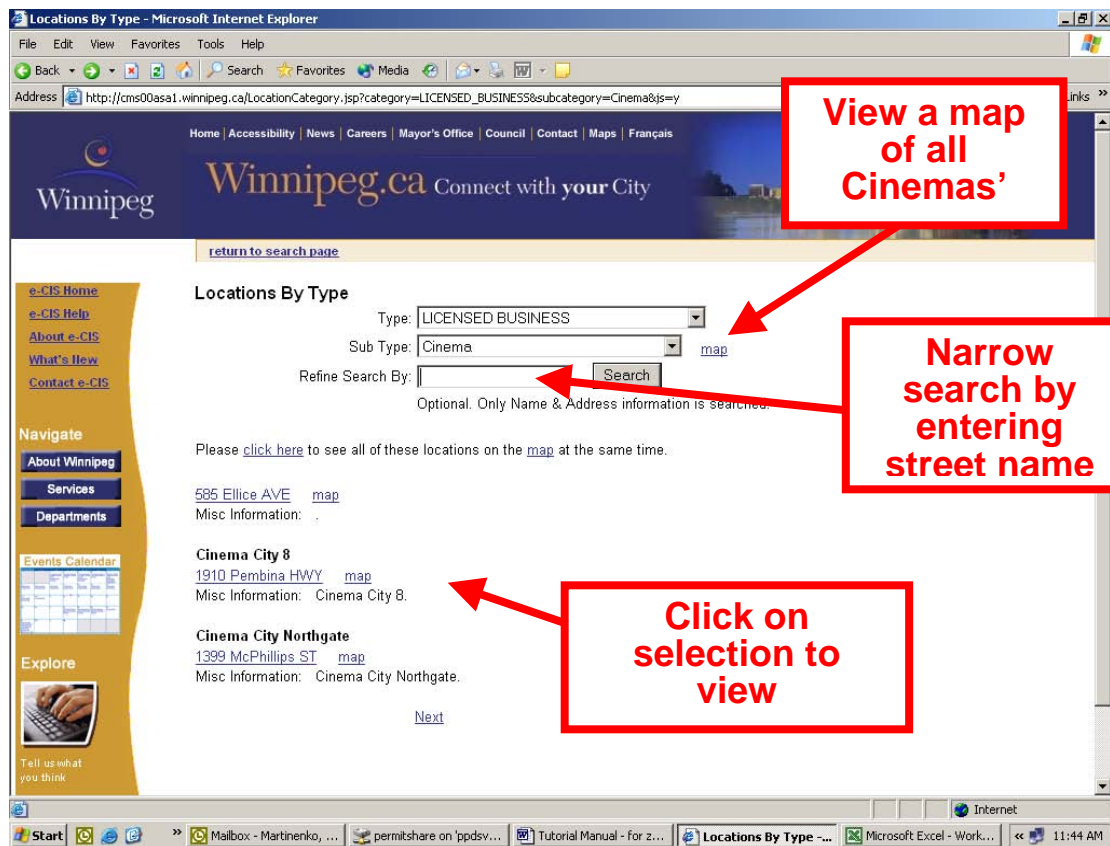
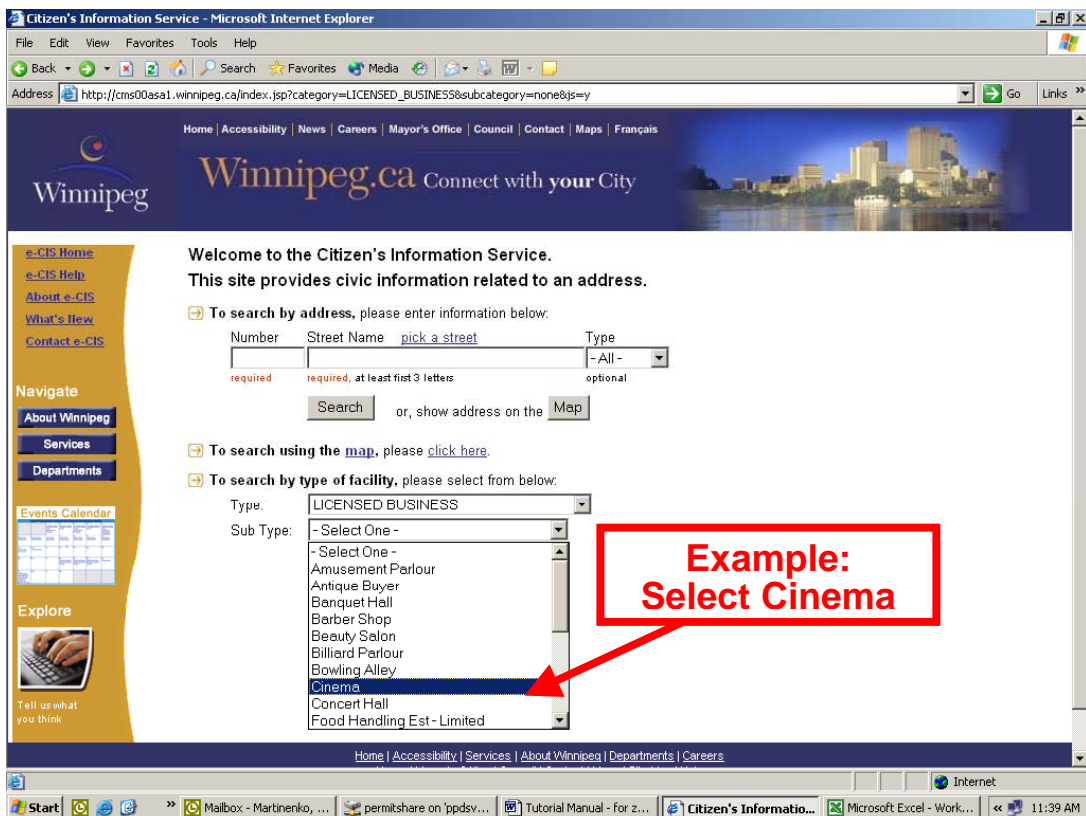
Type

The system will allow you to select the facility type from the drop down list provided. Once a type is selected, associated subtypes will be made available

Sub-Type

The system will allow you to select the sub-type for the facility type selected, from a drop down list. Once a sub-type is selected, a list of properties that match the type and sub-type selected will be displayed. You will be able to use the navigation links (previous, next) to view the entire list.
