Urban Reforestation Program

Dutch Elm Disease and other environmental factors are killing some of the mature trees in your neighbourhood. To restore the urban forest, the Urban Forestry Branch is planting new trees to replace the dying ones.

A new tree will be planted to fill an existing gap on the boulevard adjacent to your property, as indicated by a green mark. New trees are usually watered by the City or contractor for two years, however homeowners can choose to help the new tree by watering it during dry weather.
