

# DUGALD PATHWAY

## → RECOMMENDED TREATMENT:

Construct a multi-use pathway beside Dugald Road from Lagimodiere Boulevard to Plessis Road.

## → KEY FEATURES:

- 3.5 metre wide asphalt path
- 3.3 kilometres in length
- Replaces the existing intermittent sidewalks with a continuous path
- Existing traffic lights at Terracon and future traffic lights at red dashed line (below) will facilitate crossing Dugald when trail switches from north to south side
- Signage for wayfinding
- Landscaping and other aesthetic features are dependent on available funding and easements with property owners

## → KEY CONSIDERATIONS:

- Provides a fully separated walking and cycling facility along Dugald Road, a high-volume, high-speed provincial highway
- Improves facilities at existing transit stops
- Connects to existing multi-use pathway east of Plessis on north side of the road to Borden
- Connects to proposed multi-use pathway in new housing development on Dugald
- Connects to future development on Lagimodiere
