



## Inkster Boulevard Twinning Project Noise Barrier Construction

**August 18, 2010**

As part of the Inkster Boulevard Twinning Project, the Public Works Department will be constructing a noise barrier wall along your rear property line – or that adjacent to Inkster Boulevard. DDS Consulting has been contracted to construct the noise barriers. Noise barrier construction is anticipated to begin in mid-September with completion expected in November.

Public Works has arranged for the contractor to photograph and document the rear property of each home before beginning construction. This is to assess the construction requirements and to document your property so it can be restored as close to its original condition as possible when construction is complete. In order to document your property requirements and install temporary fencing, the contractor will need to access your backyard. **You will be given 48 hours notice prior to the contractor accessing your property.**

The noise barrier will be constructed on City property. The contractor will install a 1.8 metre (6 foot) high temporary chain-link fence approximately one (1) metre (3 feet) inside the private property line prior to starting work. All existing rear fences will be removed. If you would like to salvage the material from your fence, please indicate your preference on the form provided. **If we do not receive a response from you regarding the disposal or retention of your fence material, the contractor will dispose of the fencing material.**

Please take the time to complete the enclosed form to ensure we have your proper contact information and to accommodate your fencing material and landscaping requirements.
