

Speed Humps in Public Lanes: Warrant Criteria

(Approved by the Committee on Works and Operations on January 23, 1983)

The City's warrant criteria for installing speed humps in public lanes is as follows:

- (i) Receipt of a minimum 70% supporting petition* from the abutting residents in the block in question;
- (ii) A speed study indicating an 85th Percentile Speed** of at least 30 km/hour;
- (iii) Minimum lane length of 100 metres.

* Petition forms are available from the Traffic Assessment Branch.

** The 85th Percentile Speed is a common transportation engineering indicator which refers to the speed at which 85% of vehicles are traveling at or below and 15% of vehicles are traveling at or above.
