RE: 2023 SIDEWALK RENEWALS AND ASSOCIATED WORKS – BROADWAY (BOTH SIDES) FROM

SHERBROOK STREET TO SPENCE STREET

Please be advised that construction of the sidewalk on both sides of Broadway will soon begin.

Construction Start: Week of August 8, 2023

Duration: Approximately 6 to 8 weeks, weather permitting

Work will include:

- Excavation of the existing curb and sidewalk
- Construction of new concrete curb and sidewalk with paving stone banding
- New curb ramps and detectable warning surface tiles
- · Renewal of existing tree wells
- Installation of refurbished decorative street lights

During construction we will:

- Maintain one lane of traffic
- Remove on-street parking
- Maintain pedestrian access to all residences and businesses
