TO: Residents

RE: 2023 Local Street Renewal Project – Moberly Avenue - Whiteway Road to Cambie Road

Please be advised the major rehabilitation of Moberly Avenue from Whiteway Road to Cambie Road will soon begin.

Construction start: Week of September 21, 2023

Duration: 6 weeks

Work will include:

- · Roadway and sidewalk repairs
- Curb replacement
- Utility and underground infrastructure repairs and adjustments
- Placement of asphalt pavement overlay

Traffic impacts during construction:

- On-street parking will be removed
- One lane of two-way local-access traffic will be maintained
- During some portions of the work, the street will be completely closed to traffic and private approaches will not be accessible
 - In these situations, you will be notified at least 24 hours prior to the disruption of access.
- Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times
 - The contractor may relocate bins if required

Anyone with accessibility needs, moving requirements, planned special events, any underground appurtenances, such as sprinkler systems, lighting cables, etc. within 6 metres (20 feet) of the street curb line or any other questions are asked to contact Richard Hawkins from WSP Canada Inc. at (204) 477-7608, during regular working hours or by email at info.wpg@wsp.com.
