TO: Residents/Businesses of River Avenue and Wellington Crescent

RE: River Avenue / Stradbrook Avenue / Wellington Crescent Pavement Renewals and Protected

Bike Lanes

Please be advised the major rehabilitation of River Avenue between Wellington Crescent and Osborne Street and Wellington Crescent between River Avenue and Stradbrook Avenue will soon begin.

Construction start: Week of August 14, 2023

Duration: 14 Weeks

Work will include:

- Repair the roadway pavement and replace curbs
- · Repair and adjust underground infrastructure
- Place an asphalt pavement overlay
- Repair sidewalks and restore boulevards where required
- Install new protected bike lanes
- Construct Transit stop and pedestrian crossing improvements
- Upgrade Traffic signals

Traffic impacts during construction:

- On-street parking will be temporarily removed
- One lane of traffic will be maintained
- One sidewalk will remain open at all times
- During some portions of the work, private walkways and approaches will not be accessible
 - You will be notified at least 24 hours prior to the disruption of access
- Garbage and recycling will continue to be picked up at regular locations and times
 - The contractor may relocate bins if required
