RE: 2023 NEW MULTI-USE PATHWAYS, PATHWAY RENEWALS AND TBO PROGRAM – REFINERY DISTRICT BRT PATHWAY CONNECTION FROM BRT STATION TO BALLANTRAE DRIVE

Please be advised that the above New Multi-Use Pathway project has been approved for construction this summer as part of the City of Winnipeg's 2023 New Multi-Use Pathways Program.

Preliminary information for this project is as follows:

Construction Start: May to September 2023

Duration: Approximately 6-8 weeks, weather permitting

The work on Refinery District BRT Pathway Connection will include:

- Excavation of boulevard
- Installation of Culverts
- Laying a new sub-base and base structure
- Asphalt paving the new path
- Boulevard regrading and restoration as required

Traffic and Access Management

Access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
