Smoking on Outdoor Patios at Restaurants and Bars By-law Review

Update

In the fall of 2017, stakeholder meetings, an online survey and a statistically significant telephone survey were held to gather public input on patio smoking at restaurants and bars in Winnipeg. A [Public Engagement Summary](#) and full [Public Engagement Report](#) are now available and provide a summary of the public engagement process undertaken and the feedback collected for the review.

An [administrative report](#) outlining recommendations on how to move forward with regulating smoking on outdoor patios and a review of practices in other Canadian cities has been developed. The report will be presented at the [January 9, 2018 Standing Policy Committee](#) on Protection, Community Services, and Parks.
