Engagement Updates

Wellington Crescent Public Engagement Summary

In June and July 2020, the Wellington Riverbank, Path, and Roadway project team shared an updated design and gathered feedback from the community.

Soil Fabrication Program

Over the summer, the public was invited to learn more and provide feedback on the City's soil fabrication program. The soil fabrication program uses a mix of biosolids, woodchips, and street sweepings to produce soil that will help restore the landfill to a native prairie landscape.
