Henderson Highway North Improvements Study



The Henderson Highway North Improvements Study is starting. The study is looking to improve safety, traffic flow, and livability along Henderson Highway from Gilmore Avenue to the north city limit at Glenway Avenue.

Our first task is to meet with directly impacted property owners (to gather property-specific information) and to hear from Winnipeggers about existing conditions and issues in the area. We are asking the public to identify current issues and experiences on the [interactive map](#). The [interactive map](#) will be available until November 6, 2021 on the [project webpage](#).

The input collected during Phase 1 of public engagement will help the project team create a functional design. A functional design is used to support some early decision making and to support the next level of design but not construction.
