

## **Grant Park Campus Plan and Feasibility Study Survey**

### **Prize Draw Rules and Regulations**

1. **CONTEST PERIOD:** This Contest starts on Wednesday, March 15, 2017 and closes on Friday, April 21, 2017 at 12:00 noon. The draw will take place before 4:30 pm on Friday, April 21, 2017. The Contest is sponsored and will be administered by the City of Winnipeg (the “City”) in conjunction with HTFC Inc.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** This Contest is open to all legal residents of the City of Winnipeg who are eighteen (18) years of age or older at the time of entry into the Contest. The City reserves the right to require proof of age and jurisdiction of residence prior to awarding any prize. Employees, agents and representatives of the City are not eligible to win, nor any person with whom such employee, agent or representative is domiciled. Likewise, employees, agents and representatives of HTFC Inc. are not eligible to win, nor is any person with whom such employee, agent or representative is domiciled.
3. **PRIZE:** There is a total of one (1) prize to be given away consisting of a Certificate for two (2) Tour Visas for the 2017 Folklorama Festival, which is valued at \$550 (the “Prize”). The Certificate will be sent to the selected Entrant and the Entrant will be responsible for exchanging the Certificate for the Tour Visas between July 17 and July 21, 2017. Each Tour Visa entitles the bearer to unlimited admission to all Folklorama pavilions during the festival, but does not permit the bearer to by-pass lineups and will not secure food or beverages for the bearer.
4. **HOW TO PARTICIPATE:** All Entrants may enter the Contest by following the link provided in the e-newsletter or by accessing it directly at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/S2ZN3TK>. Entrants will receive one (1) entry for completion of the Grant Park Campus Plan and Feasibility Study Survey.
5. **PRIZE DRAW:** The winner will be determined by random drawing from all eligible entries received during the Contest Period. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received.
6. **PRIZE AWARDING:** The Prize will be awarded only on verification by the City that all contest requirements have been met by the winner. The Prize must be accepted as awarded and no substitution, transfer, conversion or assignment of the Prize will be allowed. No correspondence will be entered into except with the selected Entrant at the email address listed in the completed survey. The City will notify the winner by email within ten (10) business days of the relevant draw date. The Winner will have three (3) business days from notification to accept the Prize by email and will be instructed whom to contact at that time. The City is not responsible for and shall not be liable for late, lost, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify the winner. If the selected Entrant cannot be contacted or fails to respond within the allotted time, the City reserves the right to void that entry and select another eligible Entrant for the Prize. In order to be declared an official winner, the selected Entrant must correctly answer a skill-testing mathematical question without mechanical or other assistance. If the selected Entrant provides an incorrect answer to the skill-testing question, the City reserves the right to void that entry and select another eligible Entrant for the Prize.
10. **GENERAL:** By entering the Contest, Entrants agree to abide by these Contest Rules and Regulations and the decision of the City, which are final.

11. **DISQUALIFICATION:** The City is not responsible for lost, interrupted or unavailable network server or other connections, miscommunications, failed telephone or computer transmissions or technical failure, jumbled, scrambled or misdirected transmissions, or other error of any kind whether human, mechanical or electronic. Persons found tampering with or abusing any aspect of this Contest or the survey will be disqualified. In the event any portion of this Contest is compromised by virus, bugs, non-authorized human intervention or other causes beyond the control of the City, which in the sole opinion of the City, corrupts or impairs the administration, security, fairness or proper entry into the contest, the City reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to suspend or terminate the Contest and to award the Prize to an individual selected at random from the pool of Entrants received up to the point of termination.

12. **TAX INFORMATION:** Liability for any applicable taxes imposed by any government, if any, on the Prize is the sole responsibility of the winner.

13. **GOVERNING LAW:** Entrants acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of the Contest or these Rules and Regulations will be governed by the laws of the Province of Manitoba and the federal laws of Canada.

14. **DISCLAIMER:** The City shall not be responsible or liable to Entrants for any losses, damages, or costs incurred as a result of Entrants entering the Contest or use of the Prize won in connection with this Contest. By participating in the Contest, each Entrant agrees to release and hold harmless the City, its employees, officers, directors, agents, and representatives harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims and actions of any kind in connection with the Contest or resulting from acceptance, possession, or use of the Prize including, without limitation, personal injury, death, and property damage, and claims based on publicity rights, defamation, or invasion of privacy.

15. **DATA PROTECTION NOTICE:** The Entrant's personal information is being collected under the authority of 36(1)(b) of The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. This information will be used to administer the contest and will not be used or disclosed for any other purposes, except as authorized by law.
