PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

Revise: B6.7 to read: Further to B6.5 and B6.6, the unbound original should be submitted on standard letter size paper (8 ½ x 11 inches) and limited to a maximum of 12 pages, excluding the forms required in B6.1. The additional copies may be submitted on standard letter size paper (8 ½ x 11 inches) and the Project Schedule referred to in Clause B6.2 (c) may be submitted on ledger size paper (11 x 17 inches). Any information submitted in an appendix will not be evaluated.

Revise: B8.9 to read: The Fees associated with Contract Administration shall:

- (a) be a Total Maximum based on Hourly Rates;
- (b) include allowable Disbursements;
- (c) include Fees for supervision of any services anticipated in D4.4.2;
- (d) be entered in column (c) of Form B;

Delete: B9.2(c) (iv)

Add: B9.2.2 Further to B9.2(c), and upon request of the Project Manager, the Proponent must be able to provide, for each person identified in B9.2(a), two current references, including telephone numbers, for each project listed.

Revise: B11 to read: **PROJECT SCHEDULE (SECTION E)**

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D4.1 to read: The Services required under this contract shall consist of Professional Consulting Services related to the Reconstruction of Fort Street between Graham Avenue and Portage Avenue, based on the Estimated Scope for services including:

- Revise: D4.1(a) to read: pavement reconstruction (approximate limits from North curb line at Graham Avenue to South curb line at Portage Avenue);
- Revise: D4.1(b) to read: modifications to radii on North side of Portage Ave. to enhance Accessibility Design Standards requirements
- Revise: D4.1(h) to read: co-ordination with Water and Waste (2012 Watermain and/or Sewer works pavement reconstruction (approximate limits from North curb line at Graham Avenue to South curb line at Portage Avenue);
- Revise: D4.5 to read: The Total Project Budget approved by Council on December 13, 2011, is \$2,100,000.00, (including an estimated amount of \$500,000 for streetscape components). The Capital Construction Estimate included in the Total Project Budget is \$1,400,000.00. Revise:
D11.1 (a) to read: substantial performance of all construction contracts by the end of the 2012 construction season and total performance of all construction contracts by June 1, 2013

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q3(a) Can Water & Waste provide information on any work that is in the vicinity with this project?

A3(a) It is anticipated the Water and Waste will complete a watermain renewal on Fort Street between Graham and Portage, with expected construction completion by June 30, 2012.

Q3(b) Can W&W provide information that is expected to be completed as a part of this project?

A3(b) The consultant should review the SMS for any necessary sewer video requirements in the area as per Clause E2.2(d) and Clause E7 of specifications (following PWD guidelines).

Q3(c) Does W&W have any known significant infrastructure in the vicinity (ie: feeder mains) which would require additional reports?

A3(c) There is no feeder main on Fort (Graham to Portage).
