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PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

Add: E9. Entry onto Easements Within Private Property

- E9.1 The Contractor shall inform the Contract Administrator a minimum of five Working Days prior to entering onto private property to complete any Work within an easement.
- E9.2 The Contractor shall inform the Contract Administrator when communication between the Contractor and any private property owners is required. The Contract Administrator will convey any and all communication to the property owners on behalf of the Contractor that is outside of the normal notifications required as part of this Contract.
- E9.3 The Contractor shall not enter onto any easement without the consent of the Contract Administrator.
- E9.4 The Contractor shall confine the Work within the limits of the easement.
- E9.5 The Contractor shall ensure that any and all damage that is a result of his operations is repaired, regardless of if it is within or outside of the easement. The repair shall be equal to, or better than the original condition prior to the start of the Work. Any damage shall be repaired at the Contractor's expense to the satisfaction of the Contract Administrator.
