Revise: E2.8(l) to read: with reference to **E2.8(k)**: AVL devices should allow polling by a remote software (such as AVL Monitoring Software) for on-demand data transmission to the host server;

Revise: E2.8(m) to read: with reference to **E2.8(k)**: AVL devices should be configurable to adjust parameters of any of the update triggering events;

Questions and Answers

Q1 For the purpose of budgeting for the security of 50% of the Contract Price, is the Price only the product of hardware cost times the quantity (plus server costs if any)? I assume monthly fees and training costs do not factor in? If they do, how many months are factored and is there an expectation on the qty of training sessions?... And installation costs... Is that also to be factored when coming up with the 50%?

A1 With reference to section D9 of the RFP: The performance bond is required only for Phase-2 and shall be in the amount of 50% of the Contract Price. Performance bond is not required for Phase-1 (trial and testing phase). "Contract Price" shall be sum of all purchases to be made for phase-2 under the contract. As to the length of performance bond term, section D9.1 lists that to be "...until the expiration of warranty period...".
