Good Afternoon,

Due to the fact that the Engineered Wetlands are for the treatment (sedimentation, possible nutrient reduction, flow equalization) of surface water from the Development, no engineered liner is required underneath the wetlands or clean water drainage ditches identified in the Surface Water Management Plan – Scope dated 10-Jan-13 for the ‘clean surface water’.

It is the understanding that impacted water from the composting area(s), active waste disposal cells and material storage areas will be separated from the ‘clean’ surface water, and a portion of it (that is not treated or removed from site by other means) will be routed through the system identified as the ‘impacted system in the 10-Jan-13 document. For this water course and wetland, due to the impacted nature of the water, the requirements will be a minimum of 1 metre clay liner to 1×10^{-7} cm/s or equivalent.
