## PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

Revise: D13.2 to read: Further to D23.1, should the Public Works Department require that Work on Regional Streets be carried out at night, on Sundays, on Public Holidays, or that work be restricted or suspended during peak traffic hours, the Contractor shall comply without additional compensation being considered to meet that requirements. Notwithstanding the above, construction activities on Selkirk Avenue will be permitted weekdays, during normal construction hours provided traffic is maintained as specified in D23.4(a).

## Add: D27 WORK BY OTHERS

D27.1 Work on or near the site will include but not necessarily be limited to:

(a) Manitoba Hydro will be relocating underground street light service to temporary overhead within the limits of the watermain construction. Manitoba Hydro will also be de-energizing the decorative lighting within the limits of the watermain construction. These operations are anticipated to be complete prior to the commencement of the watermain renewal.
