- **Q3**: Does the City use any additional GeoMedia products connecting to the proposed public works Oracle database? These could be GeoMedia Public Works, GeoMedia Transaction Manager etc. Please provide a list.
  - A3 The Water & Waste Division is currently running the following versions of GeoMedia products: GeoMedia Public Works - v06.01.02.03 Geomedia Grid - v06.01.28
- Q4: What version of Oracle RDBMS are you running in your production environment?
  - A4 The Water & Waste Division is currently running the following version of Oracle: Oracle Database 11g
- **Q5**: What technology do you currently employ to enable storage and querying of temporal data? Such as historical data or data that has been archived by the City in the GIS.
  - A5 GeoMedia Desktop, the same as the current data.
- **Q6**: A feasible architectural pattern would be to deploy two separate databases for GeoMedia and ArcGIS for Desktop and synchronize deltas between the two. Would the City be open to such deployment pattern?
  - A6 The City is open to any proposed solution that follows proven architectural patterns and best practices used in the industry. Proponents should provide evidence where such architectural patterns have been successfully applied in actual production implementations, similar to that being proposed for the City.
