Revise: E6.1.3 to read: During pavement rehabilitation work from Erin St to Dominion St, intersecting local

streets and private approach access shall be maintained at all times unless joint/slab

repairs or planing/paving operations require temporary closure. During reconstruction of the eastbound lanes from Dominion St to Arlington St, side streets and back lane accesses to Ellice Ave are to be closed for construction. Similarly, closures on the north side of Ellice will apply for westbound lane reconstruction Temporary closures are to be staggered such that consecutive intersections are not closed at the same time. Required temporary closures at intersection local side streets are not to occur on refuse/recycling days. Traffic on intersecting regional/collector streets (Erin St., Wall St. and Arlington. St.) shall be maintained at all times with a minimum of two lanes on Erin St. and two lanes on Wall St. during peak traffic hours. Temporary complete closures shall be no longer than 10 minutes during asphalt planing/paving operations and shall be completed during off peak hours.

Revise: E6.1.6 to read:

In the pavement rehabilitation section (Erin St to Dominion St) maintain pedestrian access on both sidewalks, as possible. In the reconstruction section (Dominion St to Arlington St) maintain sidewalk on the opposite side to the reconstruction phase. Contractor to close side of reconstruction and provide safe crossing at all side streets. Pedestrian access must be maintained on both sides of Ellice Ave. at all times where residents/businesses access is off of Ellice Ave (Burnell St to Arlington St). One pedestrian crossing in the north-south direction must be maintained at each intersection at all times.

Add: E6.1.8

Access to the 7-Eleven convenience store at the intersection of Ellice Avenue and Arlington St must be maintained at all times for the duration of the project.

Add: E15.2(b) Insu

Insulation shall conform to SD-018 and be 100mm thick.

Add: E19. Refuse and Recycling Collection

E19. REFUSE AND RECYCLING COLLECTION

While access to refuse and/or recycling collection vehicles is restricted, on collection day(s) the Contractor shall move all of the refuse and/or recycling materials from the west boulevard to the east boulevard of the same street, prior to an established time, in accordance with E19.2 to permit the normal collection vehicles to collect the materials. Immediately following recycling collection the Contractor shall return recycling receptacles to the addresses marked on the receptacles.
