Revise E2 to read:

E2. WATER SUPPLY

- E2.1 Further to Section 3.14 of CW 2140 and Section 3.7 of CW 1120 of the General Requirements water supply for the Work may be taken from City of Winnipeg hydrants in accordance with the following procedure.
 - (a) The Contractor shall be permitted to use one hydrant at any one time during the Work. Furthermore, only one hydrant shall be authorized for use in each area as depicted per drawing (ie. Drawing No. 1 thru 16). The Contract Administrator will then arrange for one hydrant use permit to be obtained for the contract.
 - (b) The Contractor shall submit a list of proposed hydrant locations to the Contract Administrator who will submit the locations to the City of Winnipeg Water Services Division (WSD) for approval. Only hydrants approved by the WSD shall be used for water supply. If a proposed hydrant location is not approved, the Contractor shall submit an alternate hydrant location for approval.
- E2.2 The Contractor shall make the following arrangements for hydrant turn ons and turn offs.
 - (a) Contact Water Services Division (WSD) for hydrant turn ons and turn offs required between 0800 hours and 1500 hours Monday to Friday. Notice for turn ons shall be provided on the previous business day.
 - (b) Contact Emergency Services Branch (986-2626) with a minimum of 2 hours notice for hydrant turn ons and turn offs required outside of the above hours.
 - (c) The Contractor shall wait at the hydrant from the requested time until the City arrives to turn on or turn off the hydrant.
- E2.3 Hydrants approved for use shall be considered to be "in the Contractor's control" from the time the City has turned the hydrant on until the City has turned the hydrant off.
- E2.4 Between November 1 and April 30 of any year the Contractor shall be responsible for the following.
 - (a) Taking all necessary precautions to prevent freezing of hydrants and related appurtenances for hydrants in their control.
 - (b) Maintenance and repair of damage to the hydrant and appurtenances caused by freezing while in their control.
 - (c) Pumping out all hydrants at time of being turned off.
- E2.5 Water Services Division may at their discretion, allow the Contractor to turn approved hydrants on and off provided the Contractor has received training by Water Services Division and the turn ons and turn offs are done in the presence of the Contract Administrator.
- E2.6 The Contractor shall be responsible to repair damage to hydrants, appurtenances and watermains as a result of performing improper hydrant turn on and turn off procedures.
