PART E - SPECIFICATIONS

GENERAL

E1. GENERAL

- E1.1 These Specifications shall apply to the Work.
- E1.2 Where the word "Owner" is found on the Drawings replace with City of Winnipeg.
- E1.3 Where the word "**Consultant**" is found on the Drawings replace with Contract Administrator.
- E1.4 The following Drawings are applicable to the Work:

E2. GOODS

- E2.1 The Contractor shall supply and deliver acrylic interior directional signs in accordance with the requirements hereinafter specified.
- E2.2 The Winnipeg (interior) walkway system in Downtown has been named the "W", and will be marked by a directional sign system. Many of the signs will feature a three (3) dimensional "W" logo, to be made of painted MDF material.
- E2.3 Acrylic sheets are to be painted (except for white sub-panels), with 3-D logo and cut vinyl letters applied as indicated on the attached detail sheets. Many of the panels will feature "sub-panels" to be attached to the main panel using 3M <u>VHB</u> tape, as per the manufacturer's specifications.

NOTE:

- (a) Four (4) of the signs are double sided, thus there are 21 sign <u>sides</u> to be prepared,
- (b) Nine (9) of the sign <u>sides</u> do NOT have a 3-D logo, thus only 12 3-D logo are required.
- E2.4 For the Contractor reference only, signs suspended from ceiling will be attached using Mustang System stainless steel units which attach to the sign with friction screws, no holes required. The signs that will be attached to walls will be attached using 3M <u>VHB</u> tape.

E3. DELIVERY

- E3.1 Goods shall be delivered by November 09, 2004, f.o.b. destination, freight prepaid to 65 Garry Street. The Contractor shall confirm the delivery date to the Contract Administrator, if **the location changes**, the Contract Administrator will update the delivery address to the Contractor.
- E3.2 Goods shall be delivered between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on Business Days.
