TERMS AND CONDITIONS – SURPLUS GOODS

- BIDDING PROCEDURES The Bid must be submitted on the forms provided, with all required entries made clearly 1. 1.1 in ink
- If the Bidder finds discrepancies or omissions in the Offer of Surplus Goods for Sale or 1.2 any part thereof, or is unsure of the meaning or intent thereof, he shall notify the Buyer. The Buyer will, if he deems it necessary, issue addenda to all Bidders. The Bidder is advised to direct all enquiries or comments to the Buyer at least five (5) business days prior to the Submission Deadline to allow time for the preparation and distribution of necessary addenda.
- The Bidder is responsible for inspecting the goods, the nature of the Work to be done and all conditions that might affect his Bid or his performance of the Work, and shall assume all risk for conditions existing or arising in the course of the Work which have been or could have been determined through such inspection. 1.3
- The Bid must be submitted enclosed and sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the RFQ Number and the Bidder's name and address. Each envelope must contain only the Bid for one Offer of Surplus Goods for Sale. 1.4
- The Bid must be submitted to the Materials Management Division at the address specified no later than the Submission Deadline specified. Bids received after the Submission 1.5 Deadline will not be considered.
- 1.6 The Bid may be withdrawn without penalty at any time prior to the Submission Deadline.
- The Bid shall be open for acceptance, binding and irrevocable for the period of time specified on the cover page. A Bidder who withdraws his Bid after the Submission Deadline but before his Bid has been released or has lapsed shall be liable for such damages as are imposed upon the Bidder by law and subject to such sanctions as the 1.7 City considers appropriate in the circumstances.
- The City may reject a Bid as being non-responsive if the Bid is incomplete, obscure or conditional, or contains additions, deletions, alterations or other irregularities. The City may reject all or any paid or waive technical requirements if the interests of the City so require. The City may reject any Bid submitted by a Bidder who does not demonstrate, in his Bid or in other information required to be submitted, that he is responsible and qualified. A responsible and qualified Bidder is one that meets the qualifications specified and is not suspended, debarred or in default under any contract 1.8 with the City
- Where the Contract is proposed in separate sections or with alternatives, the City shall have the right to award any section separately or to choose any alternative which is in its 19 best interests.
- The City will have no obligation to award a Contract to a Bidder, even though one or all of the Bidders are determined to be responsible and qualified, and the Bids are determined 1.10 to be responsive. Where an award of Contract is made by the City, the award shall be made to the responsible and qualified Bidder submitting the highest evaluated responsive Bid
- The Buyer will give written notice of the award of the Contract to the successful Bidder, or 1.11 will give notice that no award will be made.
- The Offer of Surplus Goods for Sale, including but not limited to the specifications, drawings and addenda, and the Contractor's Bid shall be deemed to be incorporated in and to form a part of the Contract notwithstanding that they are not necessarily attached to or accompany the written notice of award of Contract. 1.12

SCOPE OF WORK

- 2.1 The Work to be done under this Contract shall consist of the purchase and removal of surplus goods, and the provision of ancillary services in accordance with applicable specifications, drawings and addenda.
- The Contractor shall provide and pay for all materials, labour, equipment, tools, utilities, licenses and fees necessary to complete the Work. 22

GOODS

- All goods are sold on an "as is, where is" basis and the City makes no representation or warranty with respect to the fitness, merchantability, suitability or durability of any of the 3.1 goods for any purpose
- 3.2 The Contractor shall remove the goods within seven (7) days of notification by the City that his offer has been accepted.
- The Contractor shall inspect the goods at the time of pick up. The City shall not be responsible for any damage, defect or deterioration of the goods purported to have occurred after any prior inspection by the Contractor unless such damage, defect or deterioration is identified at the time of pick up by the Contractor. 3.3

ASSIGNMENT The Contractor shall not assign the Contract without the prior written approval of the City. 41

SUBCONTRACTING 5.1

- a) employ only Subcontractors who have successfully carried out work similar in nature, scope and value to the portion of the Work proposed to be subcontracted to them, or who are fully capable of performing the Work required to be done in accordance with the terms of the Contract;

1.1 These Specifications shall be applicable to the Work and shall take precedence over the Terms and Conditions.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 When used in this Request for Quotation:
 - (a) "Business Day" means any Calendar Day, other than a Saturday, Sunday, or a Statutory or Civic Holiday;
 - (b) "**Buyer**" means the person authorized to represent the City in respect of the Request for Quotation;
 - "Calendar Day" means the period from one midnight to the following midnight; (c)
 - (d) "Contract" means the combined documents consisting of the Request for Quotation package and any documents and drawings referred to and incorporated therein together with any submissions required to be made by the Contractor after award, and all amendments to the foregoing;
 - "Contract Administrator" means the person authorized to represent the City in respect of the Contract and (e) is identified at the time of award of the Contract;
 - "Contractor" means the person undertaking the performance of the Work under the terms of the Contract; (f)
 - "User" means a person, department or other administrative unit of the City authorized by the Contract (g) Administrator to order Work under this Contract;
 - "Work" means the carrying out and the doing of all things, whether of a temporary or permanent nature, that (h) are to be done by the Contractor pursuant to the Contract and, without limiting the generality of the foregoing. includes the furnishing of all equipment, facilities, material, labour and services necessary for or incidental to the fulfilment of the requirements of the Contract.

- 8.1 The Bidder is only required to state a price in Canadian funds for each articulated tractor or attachment they wish to purchase on Form B: Prices. However, to be considered for an Award By Section a price must be stated for each item in that Section and for an Award As a Whole a price for each item must be stated.
- 8.2 Further to 8.1 of the Terms and Conditions, the City will not consider deductions in payment for any charges (e.g., minimum pick up charges, handling charges, container deposits, etc.), except those imposed after the Submission Deadline by a government or regulatory authority having jurisdiction, unless they are identified and quantified in the Bid.

9. PAYMENTS

10. EVALUATION CRITERIA

- 11.2 The Bidder may, but is not required to, bid on all alternatives, but shall have no claim against the City if his/her Bid is rejected in favour of an award of the Contract on the basis of an alternative upon which he/she has not bid.
- 11.3 The City shall not be obligated to award any item to the responsible Bidder submitting the highest responsive Bid for that item and shall have the right to choose the alternative that is in its best interests. If the Bidder has not bid on all alternatives, he/she shall have no claim against the City if his/her partial Bid is rejected in favour of an award of the Contract on the basis of an alternative upon which he/she has not bid.
