Mounting and Docking Mobile Workstations in Vehicles

Any of these 93 vehicles could require one of the 65 mobile workstations to be mounted and docked in it, i.e. a mounting and docking station should be available in all of these 93 vehicles. (If the mounting bracket and docking station in themselves are ultra portable, and can be moved and installed easily from vehicle to vehicle (less than 30 seconds) then the availability of the mounting brackets and docking stations on spare vehicles becomes a moot point).

The service requires 65 operational portable workstations, these portable workstations will need to function in the rotation of vehicles in operation for any given day. With vehicle maintenance schedules, accidents and given the mix of vehicles that must be available at all times the concept of 28 “spare” vehicles is plausible.

As noted in document “P” the vehicle inventory changes fairly frequently in regard to vehicle makes and models, however, the volume of vehicles remains fairly constant. Vehicles with a manufacture year in the 1980s or early 90s will likely be transitioned out soon, but that vehicle will be replaced with a newer model.
