PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

- Revise: D3.7 to read: Tetra Tech will be performing a bridge deck survey using ground penetrating radar equipment in the spring of 2012 under a separate contract with the City of Winnipeg. The testing is limited to the vehicle traffic lanes only. No testing is being done on the bridge sidewalks, the shoulder barriers, or the median. The report detailing the results of the testing will be provided to the Consultant for use in the bridge deck condition assessment.
- Revise: D3.10 to read: The Water and Waste Department is considering replacing the existing cast iron watermain on the north side of Portage Avenue between Ronald Street and the east end of the bridge in 2014 or 2015. The watermain was installed in 1920. The watermain replacement work will be coordinated with the bridge rehabilitation work. The Consultant will not be responsible for designing the watermain replacement work.
- Revise: D4.1(p) to read: Investigate the feasibility of widening the bridge sidewalks without adding additional bridge girders.
- Revise: D5.1 to read: The City of Winnipeg will provide traffic control and construction crews for the purpose of localized bridge concrete removals and patching for the purposes of bridge condition assessment at no charge to the Consultant. The Consultant will be responsible for providing traffic control for all other activities including deck inspection, deck testing, and deck surveys.
- Revise: D9.3 to read: The City intends to award this Contract by May 31st 2012.
