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#### **PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS**

Revise: D8 Insurance to read:

D 8.1 The Contractor shall provide and maintain the following insurance coverage:

- (a) commercial general liability insurance, in the amount of at least **five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00)** inclusive, with The City of Winnipeg added as an additional insured, with a cross-liability clause, such liability policy to also contain contractual liability, unlicensed motor vehicle liability, non-owned automobile liability and products and completed operations, to remain in place at all times during the performance of the Work and throughout the warranty period;
- (b) Automobile Liability Insurance covering all motor vehicles, owned and operated and used or to be used by the Contractor directly or indirectly in the performance of the Work. The Limit of Liability shall not be less than \$2,000,000 inclusive for loss or damage including personal injuries and death resulting from any one accident or occurrence;
- (c) Evidence of insurance to reference that the operations **include underground work**. Commercial general liability deductible to be expressly stated on the certificate of insurance and must not exceed \$5,000.00.

D 8.2 All policies shall be taken out with insurers licensed to and carry on business in the Province of Manitoba. All policies shall be taken out with insurers licensed to and carry on business in the Province of Manitoba.

D 8.3 Pre-qualified Bidders shall provide the Contract Administrator with a certificate(s) of insurance, in a form satisfactory to the City Solicitor, at least two (2) Business Days prior to the commencement of any Work but in no event later than seven (7) Calendar Days from notification by the Contract Administrator.

D 8.4 The Contractor shall not cancel, materially alter, or cause each policy to lapse without providing at least fifteen (15) Calendar Days prior written notice to the Contract Administrator.

D 8.5 The City shall have the right to alter limits and/or coverage's as reasonably required from time to time during the continuance of this agreement.
