PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

- Add: B16.5 As a result of having provided Design-Build training to City of Winnipeg staff in relation to this Project on behalf of the Design-Build Institute of America or the Water Design Build Council, the following individuals and the companies with which they are currently employed are not eligible to be a Proponent, participate as Team Members of a Proponent, or act as advisors to a Proponent or to any of its Team Members or to otherwise participate in the development and preparation of Proposals for the Project:

 - (b) Rex Huffman - Huffman Consulting LLC, 120 Via Capri, New Smyrna Beach, Florida USA.

 - (d) Daniel D. Rawlins - InterDesign, 141 East Ohio Street, Indianapolis, Indiana USA.
 - (e) David Kinchen - Black & Veatch, Atlanta, Georgia, USA.
 - (f) Todd Larson – previously with Black & Veatch, Denver, Colorado now with MWH Denver, Colorado, USA.
 - (g) John D Doller - Carollo Engineers, 4600 East Washington Street, Suite 500; Phoenix, Arizona USA.
- Add: B16.5.1 A Proponent may be disqualified if any of the above-noted ineligible Persons (as defined in the General Conditions for Consulting Services) participate in the development and preparation of the Proposal for the RFP 182-2015.
- Add: B16.5.2 If a Proponent considers that they should be eligible they may disclose the circumstance in accordance with B16.6.2 and request an advanced interpretation.

Add: B16.6 **Conflict of Interest.**

Add: B16.6.1 Proponents must not include among their Team Members or Key Individuals any business entity or individual who is, or is associated in any way likely to create a conflict of interest or a perception of conflict of interest, with any of the following:

- (a) Any advisor, trainer or Consultant retained by the City in relation to the Project, including but not limited to consultants or lawyers providing engineering, process, finance or financial capacity advice (see also B16.2, and B16.5); or
- (b) The Fairness Advisor for the Project or his Firm (See B16.4).

Add: B16.6.2 If a Proponent considers that a particular relationship or association does not create a conflict of interest and will not create a perception of conflict of interest, but is concerned that the City could arrive at a different conclusion, the Proponent should fully disclose the circumstances to the City at the earliest possible date, and request that the City provide an advance interpretation as to whether the relationship or association will be likely to create a conflict of interest or a perception of conflict of interest.

Add: B16.6.2 Failure to comply with this provision may result in disqualification of your Submission from the RFP process or, if the City becomes aware of your breach of this provision after the RFP has been issued, disqualification from the RFP process.
