PART B – BIDDING PROCEDURES

- Revise: B2.1 to read: The Submission Deadline is 12:00 noon Winnipeg time, December **19**, 2019.
- Revise: B6.7 to read: Proposal format, size of pages and, font, etc., will not be regulated, except that the number of pages is limited to **forty (40)** and the Proposal should contain a table of contents, page numbering and should be in the Sections identified above. Proponents are encouraged to use their creativity to submit a Proposal which provides the requested information for evaluation and other information which illustrates the strength of their team.

PART D – SUPPLEMENTAL CONDITIONS

- Add: D5.5.3. Proponents may choose to submit Proposals for both this and the public engagement Request for Proposal. Personnel forming the project team for this study may also be included as part of the public engagement services project team.
- Revise: D5.4.1 (g) to read: After Phase 2 of Public Engagement, in consultation with the Technical Steering Committee, re-evaluate conceptual options based on criteria developed under D5.4.1(d) and the public input. Recommend **up** to two (2) preferred options **for each component of the study (area of improvement) listed in D5.4.1(a)** to be developed to a full Functional Design. These preferred options may be variations of those developed at the conceptual stage.
- Revise: D5.4.2 (a) to read: Proceed in developing a functional design for the selected options **for each component of the study (area of improvement) listed in D5.4.1(a)**, which includes drawings, aesthetically pleasing artistic renderings, Class 4 cost estimate (expected accuracy of +50% to -30%), and risk assessment.
- Revise: D5.6.1 to read: Conduct surface and sub-surface site explorations, measurements, investigations and surveys as required.
- Revise: D5.7.2 (a) to read: **City of Winnipeg existing pavement condition assessment data will be provided to the successful proponent.** Undertake a condition **assessment to supplement this data, analyze the current treatment recommendations**, and consult with the Project Manager prior to recommending renewal treatment for existing pavement and sidewalks.

- Revise: D5.7.3 b) to read: The project will have its macro traffic modelling performed in-house by the City's Transportation Division and the micro simulations are to be performed by the successful Consultant. Micro-simulations are to be performed to quantify the impacts of access management and improvements to operations. Either Synchro or PTV Software can be used to model the study area. **Microsimulations are not a requirement.** The projected traffic design year will be 2041.
- Revise: D5.8.3 (a) to read: Perform hydraulic and hydrologic analysis to determine the appropriate size and type of hydraulic openings. Consult with the Water & Waste Department to confirm acceptability. **Existing available City of Winnipeg HEC-RAS model data (Seine River) may be provided to the successful proponent upon request. Consultant to provide updated HEC-RAS model with the functional design scheme for the proposed crossings at the conclusion of the project.**
- Revise: D5.9.2 to read: The Take into consideration preservation of the Happyland Park property and minimize the impact of the conceptual design options and the preferred functional design option developed in D5.7, in the vicinity of the location identified more specifically in **D5.4.1(a)(iii).**
- Delete: D5.6.2
- Revise: D8.3 to read: The City intends to award this Contract by January **28**, 2020.
- Revise: D9.2 (k) to read: Development and submission of Functional Design Public Engagement Materials for City Review in early spring **2021** (as per Phase 3 scope of RFP 887-2019)
- Revise: D9.2 (l) to read: Submission of approved Functional Design Public Engagement Materials in Spring **2021** (as per Phase 3 scope of RFP 887-2019).
